

Instructions for Viewing the New Commissioner's Court Agenda

1. Open the Agenda
2. Save it to your computer
3. Open the saved Agenda and do the following:
4. Go to **View** on the **Menu Bar** at the top of the screen (see **Figure 1**)
5. Go to **Toolbars**
6. Go to **More Tools...** and click on it
7. Scroll down to the **Page Navigation Toolbar** section (see **Figure 2**)
8. Make sure the **Previous View** and **Next View** options are checked
9. Click the **OK** button
10. Click on the **Bookmarks Icon** on the left side of the screen (see **Figure 3**)
11. Click on the **Options Dropdown** (see **Figure 4**)
12. Click on **Use Current Appearance as New Default** (see **Figure 5**)
13. Save the document to keep the settings

You can view the Agenda without going through to steps above. Doing them makes navigation within the document easier.

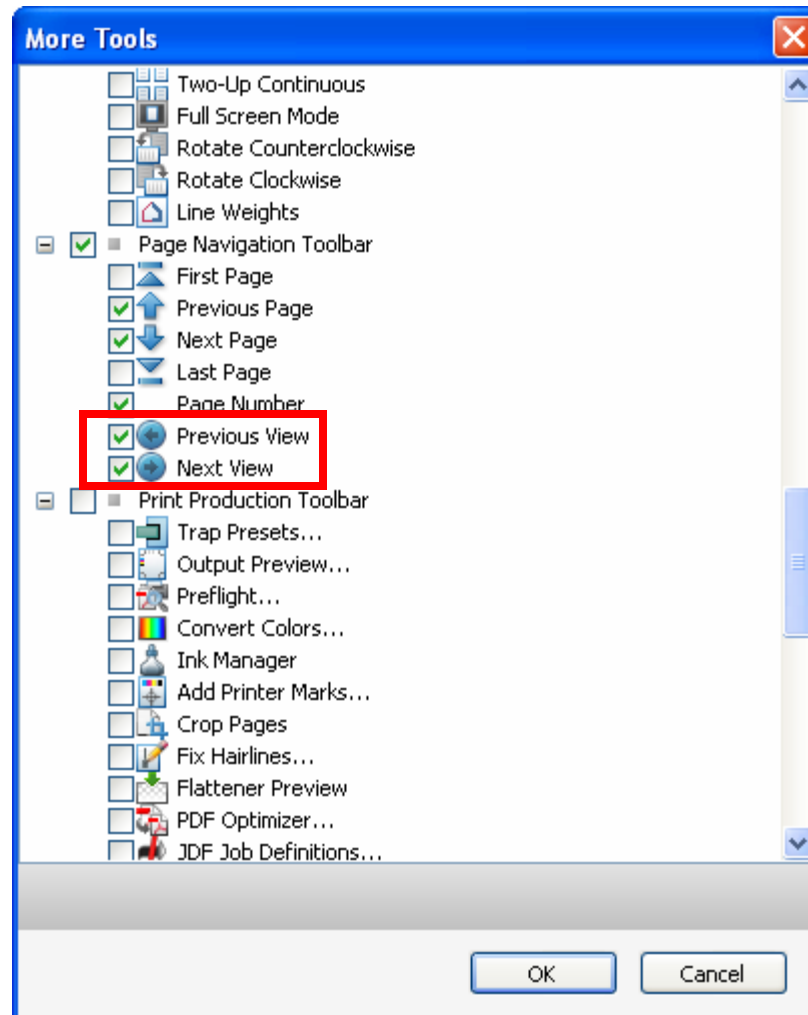
