

MANDATORY E-FILING

Beginning July 1, 2014 the Texas Supreme Court (Misc. Docket No. 12-9208) will require the District Clerk's Office to only accept electronically filed documents in all Civil, Family and Probate cases. From that date forward, if a filing by an attorney is not electronically filed, the District Clerk's Office will be required to reject it.
