Breast and cervical cancer screening, follow-up of abnormal breasts and pap smears, qualified referrals, personalized education and counseling, and case management as required. Free mammograms for those who qualify.

DIABETES PREVENTION / MEND & PATIENT NAVIGATOR SERVICES

Investigates complaints involving food service, swimming pools and general sanitation. Administers on-site sewage facilities program. Investigates reported diseases.

Texas Vaccines for Children Immunizations for ages 0-18 (eligibility required). Routine Vaccines for adults including Hepatitis A and B, Meningococcal, Influenza, Polio, etc.; and travel vaccines including Typhoid and Yellow Fever.

Services Provided:

Performs both clinical and environmental tests. Environmental testing includes drinking water, dairy products and shellfish. Clinical testing is conducted for STDs and other conditions through health clinics.

Services Provided:

Examination, testing, diagnosis, treatment, counseling, and education for sexually transmitted diseases and related problems. \$15 fee includes testing for Trichomonas, chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis and HIV. This charge includes medication, except for Trichomonas (Rx called in to pharmacy). Herpes type II testing additional \$30.

*All services are confidential and no one will be turned away for inability to pay.

Services Provided:

TB skin testing, X-rays, referrals, medications, laboratory services for cases, contacts and suspected cases. Skin testing for employment, school, day-care, immigration and foster families for a fee of \$15 (cash only). Skin testing only conducted on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. Patients who have recently received the MMR, Varicella, or Rotavirus vaccine must wait 6 weeks before receiving the TB skin test.

NURSE FAMILY PARTNERSHIP

Services Provided:

First-time Mother program providing education and training related to pregnancy, infancy and toddlerhood through home visits by registered nurses. Program open to Nueces County at-risk first time moms who are low income, homeless, single or adolescent. U.S. citizenship is not required. Goals are to improve pregnancy outcomes, increase parents' self sufficiency and decrease child abuse.

Services Provided:

Testing and screening for anemia, height, weight and nutritional deficiencies in both Women and children. Nutrition education, breastfeeding counseling and food cards for qualified families.
