Protection of the county road facilities and the traveling public is of vital concern. Any use of county right-of-way authorized by Texas law or otherwise would be expected to conform to the following as minimum conditions:

1. No blasting shall be performed within the limits of the right-of-way.
2. No operations shall be conducted in areas that may result in damage to the pavement, shoulders, or other roadway facilities. Impact or vibration equipment is not to be used on traffic lanes or paved shoulders.
3. Cables placed on the pavement must be arranged so they do not create a hazardous condition or rumble strip effect. All cables must be securely anchored to the roadway with materials that will not damage and/or puncture the pavement. Nails, spikes, and similar materials used for anchors must be placed beyond the pavement edge.
4. Adequate signs, barricades, flares, flagmen, etc. shall be maintained as necessary to protect the traveling public. Complete compliance with the Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices is mandatory.
5. The operations must not interfere with the free and safe flow of traffic. When operations are immediately adjacent to the pavement, all equipment should be parked and/or operated on one side of the roadway only.
6. Operations will be barred when the ground conditions are such that operations within the right-of-way would cause extensive rutting and/or tracking of mud onto the roadway surface.

7. The geophysical survey company shall restore the right-of-way to its original condition, free of any damage, including ruts or any injury to vegetation. Any costs incurred by Nueces County for replacement of signs, delineators, etc., for the removal of debris, or for any other necessary restoration work to place the county right-of-way into a condition equal to that prior to survey operations will be billed to the company at cost.
8. It should be clearly understood that Nueces County Department of Public Works does not purport to grant any right to conduct such surveys on county road right-of-way. Any actions on your part that create any liability or affect the rights of the holders of any property and/or mineral ownerships involved shall be solely your concern and responsibility.
9. Operations in any county park must be coordinated through the Nueces County Parks Department.
10. Any operation within county road right-of-way must occur only during the daylight hours.
11. This approval is valid for six months from date of issuance
12. Notify the Nueces County Department of Public Works (361) 888-0490 at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance of operations within county road right-of-way.

Nueces County Department of Public Works is not a law enforcement agency. Protection of the roadway facilities, and their use by the traveling public are, however, of vital concern. Therefore, violation of the above conditions will be cause for referral to law enforcement officials for appropriate actions.
